At AICA we believe that a quality Christian education should be available to every family that has a commitment to raising children to have a thoroughly Christian world view, regardless of income. AICA provides tuition assistance (financial aid) out of funds contributed to its scholarship fund, or out of funds budgeted for such purposes by the school board.

The purpose of tuition assistance is to provide financial aid for tuition expenses to families with demonstrated legitimate financial need. Each family receiving tuition assistance will be encouraged to gradually reduce their dependence on financial aid from the school.

AICA uses the services of Confidential Financial Analysis (CFA) to determine how much tuition assistance in which a family will qualify. CFA is a service of the Colorado corporation, Development Testing Services that has been providing schools, churches and ministries the information they need in a format that easily facilitates informed decisions.
